Our Administrative Assistant, Tracy Po, has moved on from BOMA BC. We thank her for her work at BOMA and wish her all the best in her future endeavours.



#### **Pilot Development Potential Relief Program**



The City of Vancouver has launched the Development Potential Relief Program (DPRP), a pilot initiative that offers property tax relief to eligible buildings. The program aims to address high property tax concerns among small businesses. BOMA BC is collaborating with the city to enhance the program. Eligible commercial properties must meet specific criteria, and feedback is being gathered to drive necessary improvements.
