

Premier David Eby released a letter criticizing the Bank of Canada's planned interest rate increase, saying that "People in BC are already hurting."


City of Vancouver Civic Agencies - Applications now open

CLI Jumps in Second Quarter 2023

In Q2 2023, the BCREA Commercial Leading Indicator (CLI) increased by 0.6 points to 147, with a sixmonth moving average at the same level. However, it was 4.7% lower compared to Q2 2022. It's important to note that the commercial real estate environment remains abnormal and uncertain due to COVID-19's structural impact on the economy, despite positive economic and office employment growth indicators.
