Development Potential Relief Program Continuation 2024 - Important Deadlines



City of Vancouver recently announced the extension of its Development Potential Relief Program (DPRP) into 2024, building on its successful 2023 pilot.

This initiative provides tax relief for properties facing high taxes due to development potential.


Key Updates:

• The program has been improved by extending the submission period to six weeks.

• Eligible properties must submit a declaration by **February 29th**, **2024**. Details and instructions are available <u>here</u>.
