Concert Properties successfully reduced energy consumption and emissions in commercial and residential properties through a pilot project from 2018 to 2023. Testing the 'EndoTherm' additive in building boilers led to an average energy saving of 11.3%, a 170,000 kg CO2 reduction, and over \$40,000 in savings. The company plans to expand the use of EndoTherm in other residential buildings with similar heating systems starting in 2024.
